

# Baylor University Collegiate Road Races

March 26– 27th, 2011

## Registration:

Preregistration will be available in person starting at 6pm at the Baylor Student Life Center on Friday 3/25, or online at <http://scccereg.jrdev.net>. All preregistration will close at 10pm on Friday. Preregistration prices will be \$13 per event, or \$30 for all 3.

Race-day registration will open at 8:00 am and close 15 minutes before each category start time. Entry fees on race day will be \$15 per event, or \$35 for all 3.

## Course:

Road course is a fast 15-ish mile course with one significant climb, and several more rollers. Total climbing will be approximately 300 feet per lap. There will be a feed zone on Chapel Rd near the Start/Finish pullout (Mourning Dove Ln). Pavement is a mixture of well-paved state routes, chip & seal secondary roads, and narrow county roads. There may be some gravel on the edges of the county roads. Staging will occur on Mourning Dove Ln with a rolling start to Chapel Rd. Laps will continue straight, and the finish line will turn left at the Mourning Dove turnoff. Count your own laps! The roads will not be closed, however course marshals and sheriff dept. will be present.

**Directions:** Take I-35 Exit 323 from the North, Exit 322 from the South (Exits for Lorena, TX). Take Old Lorena Rd (FM 2837) westward. Cross Spring Valley Rd (FM 2113), then look for Mourning Dove LN on your left. Continue down Mourning Dove until you see

signs for parking. Registration and starting line will be located at the popup tent Mourning Dove Ln.

## Team Time Trial (Saturday)

9 mile loop. First team off at 3:30 PM. A start list will be posted near the time trial start/finish and on the [baylorcycling.com](http://baylorcycling.com) website as soon as it is completed. Roads will not be closed, however course marshals will be present. Mass-start legal bikes only.

**Directions:** *From the North:* Take I-35 exit 322, continue on access rd looking for Old Bethany Rd on the right. *From the South:* Take I-35 exit 319 and immediately cross over interstate and continue north on access road looking for Old Bethany Rd on the left. *Both directions:* Turn on Old Bethany Rd. Follow until right turn on Box Ranch rd.

NOTE: Box Ranch Rd is part of the TT course. If you arrive after 3:30PM, do not drive through the start area.

0.7-mile fast, flat course on closed roads that cross the Brazos river twice. If available, merchandise premiums will be announced before the race start. Sprint points will be announced as well.

High School cats will race together with staggered starts.

A 30-minute break will be provided at 11:45 for the officials.

**Awards:**

Awards will be given for omnium finishers. A short ceremony will be held after the crit race on Sunday. Primes will be awarded for every event according to the collegiate scale.

**Rules and Regulations:**

All USA Cycling rules and regulations must be followed and will be enforced. All riders must have a current USA Cycling Collegiate racing license or a one-day license. One-day licenses will be available at check in for \$10. One-day licenses will not be available for Category A riders. The promoter reserves the right to shorten race distances due to inclement weather conditions. In the event the race is cancelled due to weather, there will be no make up date or refunds.

All athletes, staff and support personnel are required to sign a Baylor University Release of Liability form in addition to the standard USA Cycling form prior to competition. **You will not be allowed to participate without both forms!!**
